Red wine from Corvina,
Rondinella, Molinara, Oseleta
grapes. Quite thick ruby wine
that resembles the colour of
the precious stone. Warm,
spicy, alcoholic and quite
tannic wine.

Torgiano Riserva DOCG 2006**

Strong structured wine, the
symbol of the Italian style. Garnet
colour; spicy, ethereal, ample
scents; alcohols and poly-alcohols
are rich in taste.
Tannic and balanced wine

Meditation amber wine from
Inzolia, Catarratto and Grillo
grapes. Very persistent,
harmonious, alcoholic and
sweet wine with a pleasant
